Selection Process:

- A student presently completing Grade 10 shall be chosen for this award by a school awards committee consisting of at least 3 OSSTF members. The committee may also have a student rep if desired.

Criteria:

- The nominee is a Grade 10 student who contributes to the quality of life in the school (not necessarily a leader)
- The nominee shows concern and consideration for others without regard for personal recognition

Nomination Procedure:

- Provide all staff with the Nomination package, feel free to include and/or consult with your PSSP (Professional Student Services Personnel) and OT/LTO (Occasional Teacher/Long-Term Occasional) members in your buildings where appropriate.
- Solicit nominations of suitable Grade 10 students.
- Convene a meeting with the awards committee, review the nominations submitted and select one student as the award recipient.
